1.0 Superintendent - Walnut Grove Region

- 1.1 Presentation on Previously Proposed Middle School
 - Visiting all schools in the Walnut Grove Region from Sept-Dec 2023 to get feedback/ideas on potential future middle school
 - Why Middle School Programming?
 - Acknowledges that the transition of Grade 6-8 requires different needs of children
 - It's not about making Grade 6s older, but keeping Grade 8s younger while still preparing them for the future transition to highschool
 - Having more than one teacher
 - School Identity and connectivity (finding where they fit in)
 - More opportunity for diversity, especially for growing new skills. They will have a longer time to try new things, instead of only one year in Grade 8)
 - Building a Middle School
 - Cost VERY high
 - Where are we now?
 - No new money for land, new build or rebuild
 - How have schools adapted?
 - Cohorts
 - Taking Advantage of Staff skills
 - Gaterpod (Walnut Grove Secondary School) 52 spots per year
 - Grade 8 Identity Activities
 - Feedback from PAC
 - Positive experience with Gr 7 program at the highschool
 - Transition to highschool could be made easier with more visits throughout the Gr 7 school year
 - Platooning tried it a couple years ago and it worked well. Still happening in some Gr 6/7 classes (more teachers, etc)
 - Teacher feedback also important
 - After School Clubs parents are able to volunteer for these
 - More summer session opportunities
