2.0 Administration Report - Mr. Joo

- The new jerseys are here!!
 - long sleeve and no sleeve options in a variety of sizes
 - Grade 6/7 girls basketball team will be the first to use them at a game on January 23rd
- **Art Starts**
 - Upcoming Powwow dance presentation
 - \$700 cost that will be covered by PAC
- Buses/Field Trips
 - School has \$19 per student for the whole year
 - Bus rates have gone up:
 - \$150 for Zone 1
 - \$275 for Zone 2
 - \$350 for Zone 3
- **Student Inclusive Conferences**
 - This was piloted at other schools and this will be the first term where all schools are shifting to Student Inclusive Conferences (SIC)
 - Moving forward, 1st and 2nd term meetings will be SIC, followed by a 3rd term of traditional report cards

 - March 7th no school
